
St. Blaise Feast Day February 3rd

St. Blaise is a bishop and martyr who lived in the 4th century.

On his feast the church recalls a miracle cure associated with

him and celebrates the blessing of the throats. Blaise apparently saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone. The saint said anyone who lit a candle in his memory would be free of infection, thus candles are used in the traditional throat blessing. He is the patron saint of throat illnesses, animals, wool combers, and wool trading.

Fr. Rob will be giving the blessing of St. Blaise on Sunday, Feb. 1st. This is also Candlemas the blessing of the candles. If you have any candles at home you'd like blessed bring them on Sunday and he will give them a blessing.
