

**Updated Guidelines from the Diocese of Jefferson City**  
**September 12, 2020 until November 27, 2020**  
**Clark and Lewis Counties**

- 1. All the Faithful of the Diocese of Jefferson City and those who are present in the territory of the Diocese, are dispensed from the Obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation until 27 November 2020 provided that for days of precept they do one of the following:**
  - a. Prayerfully participate in the Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation Mass lived streamed from their parish church or chapel, the Cathedral, the Vatican or any validly celebrated Mass.**
  - b. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation and recite the Rosary of Divine Chaplet.**
- 2. Livestreaming will continue from St. Joseph Church in Canton, Mo.**
- 3. Those who are symptomatic for Covid-19 are not permitted to enter church properties in accordance with national, state and local health directives. All check their temperatures at home before going to church.**
- 4. Those who are 65 or older, and those with medical conditions are highly encouraged not to attend Mass especially if a large number of people could be present, social distancing is not maintained or facemasks are not worn.**
- 5. Facemasks are required entering church, during Communion and exiting church in the churches of Clark and Lewis Counties.**
