October Count

This fall our Diocese will again involve itself in a common pastoral practice across the United States known as the "October Count." Each individual who attends the weekend Masses across our Diocese during the month of October will be counted in order to allow for a better pastoral planning for the benefit of our parishes and our Diocese.

25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel today tells the story of a steward who mismanages his master's wealth and then acts shrewdly to secure his future. Though his motives are selfish, his actions show the value of generosity. Even a man driven by greed can see the importance of building relationships and gaining favor through kindness. This parable challenges us to think about our own use of resources. Everything we have comes from God, and we are stewards of His blessings. Do we use what we have wisely? Do we share generously, or do we hold on tightly, thinking only of ourselves? Jesus teaches that if even the greedy can recognize the benefits of generosity, His disciples should be even more willing to give. Our faith calls us to be kind and compassionate, not for personal gain, but because we know that God has given us everything. By sharing with others, we reflect God's love and fulfill His call to care for those around us.

Bishop-Elect Ralph's Journey

Fr. Ralph B. O'Donnell was born in August of 1969 in Omaha, Nebraska, the youngest of 10, to Mary Jane and the late Terrance O'Donnell. He grew up in Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. Fr. O'Donnell graduated from St. Joseph High School in 1987. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Religion from Conception Seminary College in 1993, a Masters of Divinity from St. Mary of the Lake Seminary in Mundelein, IL, in 1997, and a Master of Arts in Spirituality in 2000. Fr. O'Donnell was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Omaha in 1997 by Archbishop Elden F. Curtiss. He served as an associate pastor at Mary Our Queen and St. Vincent de Paul Parishes. He was appointed Vocation Director in 2003, and then the Urban Director of the Permanent Diaconate and Pastor of St. Bridget and St. Rose Parishes in 2008. In 2011 he was assigned to serve as Vice Rector at Conception Seminary College in Conception, Missouri. In 2015, he was appointed Executive Director of the Secretariat of the Committee for Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington, DC. In December of 2019, Fr. O'Donnell was appointed Pastor of St. Margaret Mary Parish in Omaha where he currently serves. On August 19, 2025, Pope Leo XIV announced his appointment of Bishop-Elect O'Donnell as the fifth bishop of the Diocese of Jefferson City, Missouri.

The ordination and installation of Bishop-Elect Ralph O'Donnell is Tuesday, October 28th. Time has not been announced.
