

Pope Leo XIV Appoints new Bishop of Jefferson City

Pope Leo XIV has appointed Fr. Ralph O'Donnell, 55, as the fifth Bishop of Jefferson City. The appointment was publicized Tuesday, August 19th in Washington, D.C., by Cardinal Christophe Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States.

Born in Omaha in 1969, Fr. O'Donnell was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Omaha in 1997. He currently serves as Pastor of St. Margaret Mary Parish in Omaha.

His appointment comes approximately three months after the previous Bishop of Jefferson City, the Most Reverend Shawn McKnight, was installed as Archbishop of Kansas City in Kansas. Msgr. Robert A. Kurwicki was elected to serve as Diocesan Administrator, and continues in that role until the installation of the new bishop.

Statement from Fr. Ralph O'Donnell, Bishop-Elect of Jefferson City

"I'm grateful to the Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV for this appointment. I look forward to coming to know and to serve the people of the Diocese of Jefferson City with joy. Let us pray for one another in the days ahead."

Bishop-Elect O'Donnell's ordination and installation is scheduled for October 28, 2025.
