From Sr. Jane:

Today's Gospel is one that I have tentatively chosen for my funeral. No, there's no death wish here, but my Community asks each of us to put together whatever of the funeral liturgy we would like to designate. One reason I like this Gospel is that it gives a foretaste of eternal life. It also gives some guidance for what comes immediately after the transfiguration. The disciples had to go back down the mountain and resume normal life, with all its struggles and challenges as well as its joys. To have to go back down the mountain would be a challenge, but the instruction: listen to him would also be a challenge. The disciples then didn't always get it right, nor do we. But we have the assurance that Jesus also went down the mountain and kept them around him, as He keeps us around him if we follow freely. What an assurance! May God keep it so!
