## **Confirmation news**

Following the news reported some time ago in *The Catholic Missourian* that the Diocese will be celebrating Confirmation with youth from 7<sup>th</sup> grade, parish's pastoral leaders were asked to submit possible dates for Confirmation for their parishes.

While we wait word for when the bishop will be available for our celebration, we do know that the parishes of St. Michael, Kahoka and St. Patrick in Clark County, and St. Joseph and Queen of Peace in Lewis County will have a **common Confirmation Program beginning**September 29<sup>th</sup> with all young people grades 7 through 11 eligible.

These young people and their parents are invited to the Introductory session on September 29<sup>th</sup>, 3 pm, at St. Joseph parish hall, Canton.

Registration will take place at this gathering.

Fr. Rob and Sr. Jane are putting together the various sessions of preparation that will take place between now and the celebration of Confirmation, which is anticipated to be sometime in June 2020.
