

**Sports:** Decorate the basket with a specific team's colors and include items like a ball, a water bottle, or tickets to a game


# Youth Group

### CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP RENEWAL 2025

In today's Gospel, we heard the parable of the persistent widow—a powerful example of our CSR theme from Romans 5:5:
"Hope does not disappoint." The widow's perseverance reflects the kind of hope-filled faith Jesus calls us to—a deep trust that God listens, cares, and responds.
Unlike the reluctant judge, God answers with a Father's love. This parable reminds us to pray with persistence and hope, knowing that our hope is never in vain—because God never disappoints. Through

God's grace, we are each given unique gifts, and we are called to share them in love of God and



neighbor. By prayerfully discerning how we use these gifts, we can become more intentional in serving our parish and community. Each year at Easter, we renew our baptismal promises—rejecting sin and affirming our faith—as a sign of our renewed life in Christ. Similarly, the annual Catholic Stewardship Renewal is a

chance to reaffirm our commitment to our parish and its mission. It is a concrete way to show that we belong to our parish family and support its ministries. To help with this discernment, please reflect on the questions in the "Discerning Your Talents" document (included in the bulletin) as you consider your Stewardship Renewal commitment. Stewardship papers will be passed out next weekend, 10/25 & 10/26 after Mass. Please plan to stay a few extra minutes to fill out yours and return before leaving.
