### 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Having reminded the apostles and the  
crowd that facing the coming judgment  
takes patience,  
Jesus now goes  
on to speak of  
how difficult it  
will be to wait.  
He tells them



that he has come to set the earth on fire.  
Recall that in chapter 3 of Luke's  
Gospel, John the Baptist tells the crowd  
that he is baptizing with water, but  
someone mightier is coming who will  
baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.  
The fire Jesus speaks of here is the  
distress caused by the coming judgment.  
It is also the fire of the Spirit that Luke,  
in the Acts of the Apostles, will describe  
descending on the disciples on  
Pentecost. That fire will strengthen them  
to go out to the whole world to preach  
the good news of Jesus' Resurrection.
