Greetings from St. Ann's Altar Sodality

We wish to review our 2025 annual projects and activities. In the past year, St. Ann funded the altar bread, flowers for the altar, prayer and altar candles. We also purchased a dusty rose cloth for the altar. The memorial plaque was updated with engraving of those parishioners who bequeathed money to the Church.

In February, in lieu of the annual soup supper fundraiser, we sent out letters asking for donations to help support our annual projects and activities. Thank you for your generous support. Donations were also made to two schools for scholarships in memory of Jim Ellison.

In April, we distributed 13 Easter baskets to the homebound and nursing home residents.

Each year, we try to plan a meeting out. In May, we chose to have our outing at Primos. Father Boniface and Jennifer joined us for the outing. All ladies of the parish are invited to join us. We gave Father a card and monetary gift for his birthday in June, as well as at Christmas.

We sponsored several Masses throughout the year, and sent sympathy cards to the families of those members who left this world to be with our Lord. We also provided a meal for one funeral dinner this past year.

November was our annual baby shower for the Lewis Co. Health Dept. Many nice gifts were donated for the new mothers that participate in pre-natal care in the county. This was our 27th year providing gifts to new mothers. We thank all who participated in this event. Your generosity is very much appreciated. We also supported Father Boniface for his trip to Rome, and once again donated the cost of the dinner rolls for the community Thanksgiving meal sponsored by the

Baptist Church, which is free to the public.

In December, Christmas goodie boxes were delivered to the home bound and nursing home residents. Twelve boxes were assembled and delivered. We also coordinated with NECAC in the "Adopt a Family" project. Very nice gifts were given to two families. Gift cards to County Market were also given to each family.
